4. Urgency of the scientific article.

Scientific value of the article

5. Theoretical and practical value
6. Classified methodology of the research
7. The most important features detected by the author in the article
8. Analysis and interpretation of the results, critical approach
9. Clearness of references, and degree of self-independence of the whole work

Quality of design and composition

10. Structure of work and logical succession
11. Composition quality (grammar, spelling, clearness of terms, etc.)
