

Lebesgue Master Scholarships for International Students in France

The Lebesgue Center of Mathematics is offering master scholarships for international students in mathematics in Rennes or Nantes. The stipend is 10,000 euros per year. A student applying for the first year of a master (M1) will be allowed to apply for another scholarship for the second year (M2). Foreign students will have assistance to get housing. The Lebesgue Center also provides french courses for foreign students.

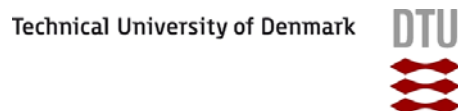
Jawaharlal Nehru Centre for Advanced Scientific Research (JNCASR) offers fellowship programme for scientists from developing countries in India. It covers short-term, participatory research studies in all major disciplines of science and technology including engineering and medical sciences at the Indian Centres of Excellence. Applicants below 45 years of age are eligible to apply. About 10 fellowships are provided annually. The duration of the fellowship is about 3 months. The application deadline is 31st October.

The Robert Schuman Centre for Advanced Studies (RSCAS) at the European University Institute (EUI) is offering postdoctoral fellowships for international applicants in an early stage of their academic career. During their stay at the RSCAS, fellows work on a research topic that fits well in the overall research profile of the RSCAS and participate in the academic life of the Center and of the EUI.
